Afternoon Team

I have been approached by some drivers in relation to fatigue management issues etc.

I will endeavour to speak to the appropriate persons in relation to this topic and surrounding issues and will get back to all in the near future.

But in saying that, fatigue management is, and should be self- managed to point, and common sense should be a big consideration.

If drivers are feeling fatigued, it is up to you to inform your go to person (Chief of Staff) and let them know you are feeling fatigued and ask to go off for a break somewhere or if you live close, head home for a rest/sleep.

It all comes down to common sense and you are the only one that knows how you feel. Of course this concept could be abused by some drivers and I hope it doesn't.

Being an ex-truck driver working under fatigue management practices, driving means driving. Just because you do a 14 hour day and drive only 4 of those hours and are not doing car related duties, the rest of hours is classed as rest time.

I regularly worked 17 hour days in which 14 of those were driving hours for 8 years or so and that is legal under the Transport Act.

I do understand where you guys are coming from and will endeavour to chase this up and find a compromise for all concerned.

Thanks to all for bringing this to subject to me.

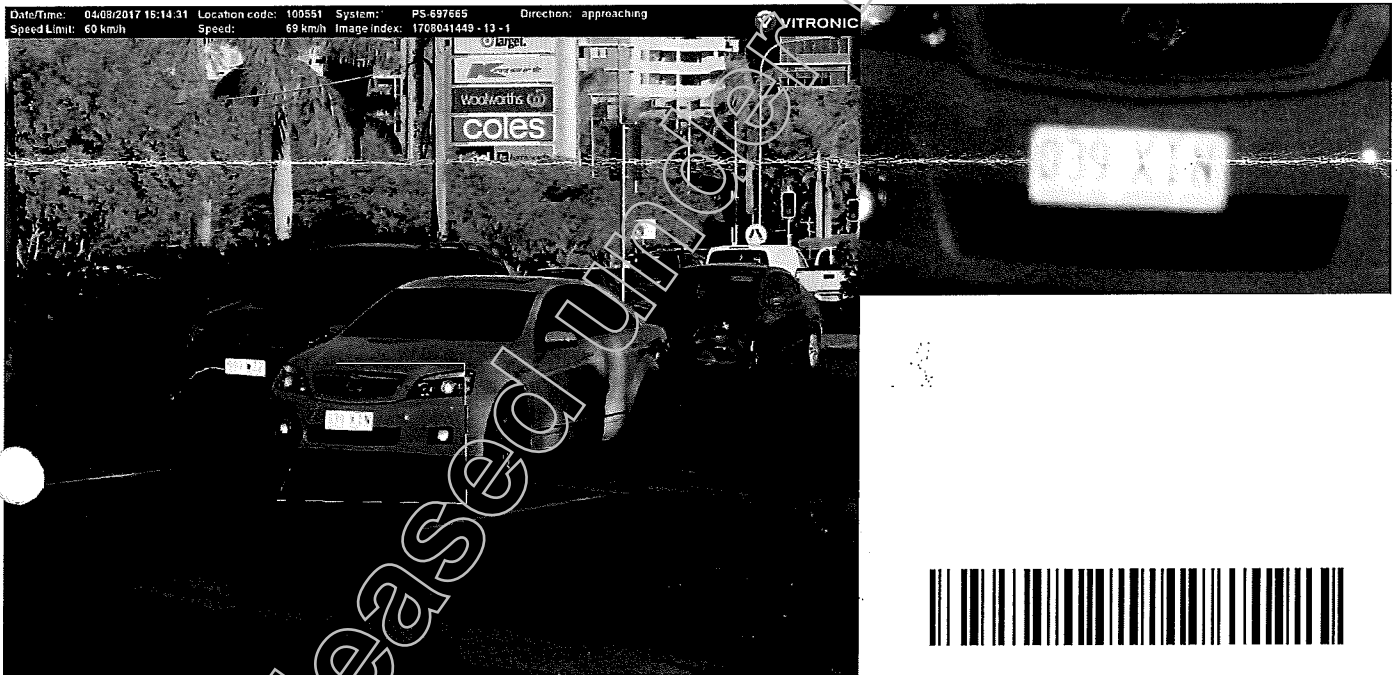

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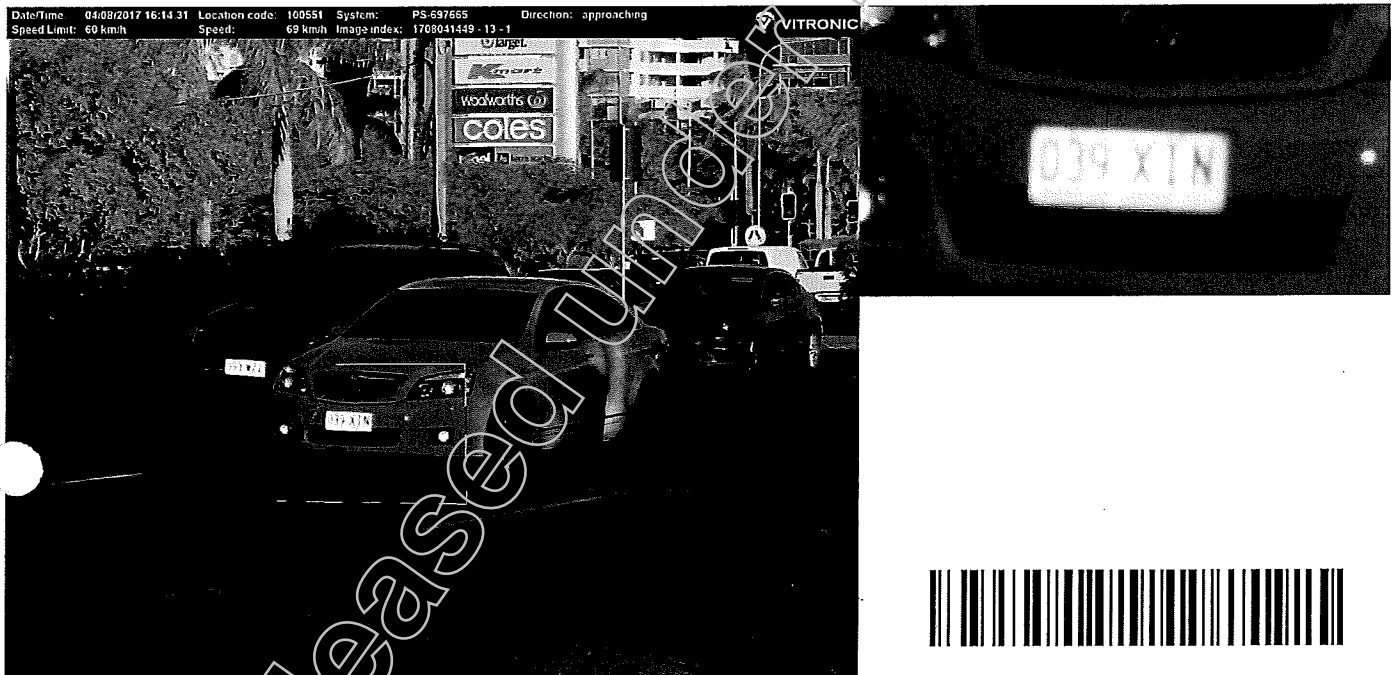
